Dear Chairman Young and Ranking Member Oberstar:



- The Bay Trail construction (Association of Bay Area Governments);
- The U.S. 101 bicycle and pedestrian bridge (City of Belmont);
- The University Avenue overpass bicycle lane (City of East Palo Alto);
- The Gateways to Ravenswood Project (City of East Palo Alto);
- The Adaptive Traffic Coordination System on Willow Road (City of Menlo Park);
- The Palo Alto Intermodal Transit Center (City of Palo Alto);
- The Intelligent Transportation System (City of Palo Alto);
- The Revenue Collection System (San Mateo County Transit District);
- The Train Tracking/Passenger Information System (Caltrain-the Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board);
- The U.S. 101-State Highway 84 interchange project (San Mateo County Transportation Authority);
- The auxiliary lanes from Marsh Road to the Santa Clara County Line (San Mateo County Transportation Authority);
- The U.S. 101-Willow Road interchange construction (San Mateo County Transportation Authority);
- The Woodside Road widening project (San Mateo County Transportation Authority);
- The Oregon-Page Mill Expressway (County of Santa Clara Roads and Airports Department);
